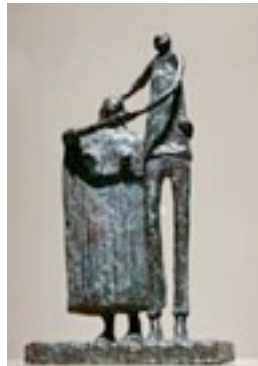

Artists and husband and wife, Roger Jacobsen and Helen Stanley stopped in from northern California to bring us his latest sculptures in steel and her beautifully crafted trompe l'oeil paintings. With intriguing works that are both serious and wry, they are favorites in the gallery.

Canadian-Vietnamese artist Khang Pham-New continues to amaze us and our clients with his abstract sculptures in granite and marble. His range includes monumental and smaller size pieces and continues to be very popular. One sculpture, "Escutcheon" is now on loan to Grounds for Sculpture in Hamilton, New Jersey. Valiance Bank in McKinney, Texas has
